### Aditi makes cut in France

Evian Les Bains: Aditi Ashok played a steady round of even par 72 to be Tied-28th after the second round of the Amundi Evian Championship, a Major on the women's circuit. Aditi added 72 to her first round 71 and was 1-over 143 going into the weekend. However, Diksha Dagar, who had a chance to make her first cut in a Major, struggled in the closing stages with two double bogeys in a second round of 81, which was 10 shots more than her first round 71. Dagar, who is lying fifth on the Order of Merit in Europe, missed the cut and will play the Women's Scottish Open next week. Aditi birdied the third and the 13th, but dropped shots on fifth, 11th and 14th.

### Malaysian team arrives in Chennai for ACT

Chennai: Malaysia men's hockey team landed here on Saturday to participate in the Asian Champions Trophy Chennai 2023, scheduled to be held from August 3 to 12 at the iconic Mayor Radhakrishnan Stadium. As one of Asia's hockey powerhouses, Malaysia have consistently showcased remarkable skills and determination on the field. They have finished third five times in the history of the tournament and will now be eyeing to clinch their maiden Asian Champions Trophy. The team has shown great promise in the recent past, having won the silver medal in the 2018 Asian Games in Jakarta-Palembang and also finished runners-up in last year's Hero Asia Cup in Jakarta.

### Lillard would honour contract: NBA

New York: The NBA told teams that Damian Lillard and his agent confirmed that the All-Star guard would honor his contract in any potential trade, despite the agent saying Lillard only wanted to be dealt to the Miami Heat. A memo sent to general managers and obtained by The Associated Press also warned that Lillard would be subject to discipline by the league if he or Aaron Goodwin make additional comments suggesting he won't fully perform the requirements of his contract in the event of a trade. Lillard told the Portland Trail Blazers earlier this month he wanted to be traded and Goodwin subsequently made clear his preference was Miami.

### Braz tests positive for doping

Monaco: Olympic pole vault champion Thiago Braz has been provisionally suspended from all competitions after a positive doping test, the Athletics Integrity Unit (AIU) said on Friday night. The 29-year-old Brazilian was found to have traces of the performance-enhancing drug ostarine in his urine following a routine test. He will face a tribunal hearing and could be banned for up to four years if found guilty, a Xinhua report said. The AIU did not disclose when the sample was taken. Braz competed in two Diamond League events in Europe in July and is preparing for the World Championships in Budapest next month.

### Bellingham adapting quite well

Texas: Real Madrid's new signing Jude Bellingham is already up and running as he scored in a pre-season fixture against Manchester United. Real Madrid manager Carlo Ancelotti said that Bellingham is adapting very well. Real Madrid defeated Premier League club Manchester United 2-0 on Thursday and will be facing Barcelona on Sunday in their pre-season tour. According to Real Madrid's website, Carlo Ancelotti appeared at the AT&T Stadium in Dallas ahead of the match against Barcelona.

### Noma Noha Akugue reaches WTA final

Hamburg: German teenager Noma Noha Akugue reached the final for the first time in the main draw of a WTA Tour tournament, continuing a meteoric rise for a player ranked 207th in the world. Noha Akugue won 6-3 6-3 against another 19-year-old, Russian Diana Shnaider, in a fairy-tale win.

# Lakshya loses in semis

The Indian player went down in three games to Jonatan Christie of Indonesia

Star Indian shuttler Lakshya Sen fought gallantly before going down in three games to world number 9 and Asian Games champion Jonatan Christie in the semifinals of the Japan Open Super 750 badminton tournament here on Saturday.

The 21-year-old from Almorá bounced back from an opening game reversal to keep his rival under pressure but in the end couldn't get across the fifth-seeded Christie, who rode on his solid defence and quality of shots to eke out a 21-15 13-21 21-16 win.

The duo had a 1-1 head-to-head count before the match and it turned out to be another pulsating contest with Sen and Christie involved in some



exquisite rallies during the 68-minute contest.

Sen is known to be faster and to negotiate his speed, Christie needed to produce high-quality shots.

However, the Indonesian wasn't consistent and made too many unforced errors initially to allow the Indian take a 7-4 lead early on. However, a

superb net shot coupled with Sen's errors on the sidelines helped Christie claw back with three points.

Sen unleashed two booming smashes to keep himself ahead and went to the interval with a two-point advantage after Christie went long and wide.

# Ledecky crosses a huge milestone

American passes Michael Phelps for most individual golds at world championships

6 First swimmer ever to win same event  
16 Number of Ledecky's individual world titles

Katie Ledecky added to her legacy as the greatest female swimmer in history when she won the 800-meter freestyle on Saturday at the World Aquatics Championships, establishing two more notable records with the triumph.

The victory by the 26-year-old Ledecky made her the first swimmer ever to win the same event six times at the world championships and also marked her 16th individual world title, breaking a tie with Michael Phelps for the most individual golds ever at

the worlds. Ledecky, who had the 30 top times ever in the 800 entering the race, led all the way, dominating her competitors and winning in a time of 8 minutes, 8.87 seconds. The gold in the 800 was Ledecky's second individual gold of these championships following her win in the 1,500 free on Tuesday.

# Chennai beat Pune in style

Indian veteran Sharath Kamal powers Lions to victory

Indian veteran **Sharath Kamal** starred as defending champions Chennai Lions defeated home favourites Purneri Paltan 8-3 to storm into their second successive final in the Ultimate Table Tennis, here on Saturday.

Chennai Lions, who won the tournament last time when UTT was held in 2019, will face Goa Challengers in the summit clash at the Shree Shiv Chhatrapati Sports Complex here on Sunday.

Goa Challengers had on Friday defeated Dabang Delhi TT to make their maiden UTT final.

In the UTT semifinals, the team that first gets to eight points - games won in the tie - are declared the winners, and against the Pune outfit it was the Commonwealth Games champion who played the decisive role to seal their final berth.

World No.34 Benedikt Duda set the ball rolling for Chen-



nai Lions, upsetting Oman Assar 11-5, 11-7, 11-6 to give his side a 3-0 headstart in the second semifinal.

The German faced no obstacles whatsoever in swatting aside the threat of Assar, ranked higher at 23.

Duda was superior in his game play and just did not allow the burly Assar to bounce back, winning all three games.

Purneri Paltan bounced back to win their first game when Hana Matelova, ranked 58, handed a 11-3 defeat to Chennai's Yangzi Liu to win

her side their first game. But the Australian Liu found her rhythm to win the next two games, eventually the contest ended 3-11, 11-8, 11-7 that extended Chennai Lions' overall lead to 5-1.

Then it was the 41-year-old Sharath Kamal who took the centrestage and guided his team to win, starting with the third match - a mixed doubles contest.

Sharath teamed up with Liu and stormed to a 11-4 win against the Purneri Paltan pair of Manush Shah and Matelova in the first game.
